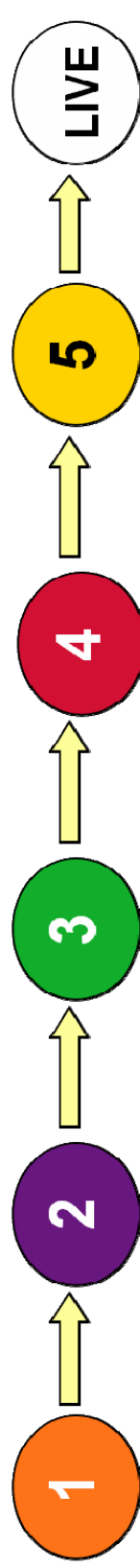


GCSx Implementation Process

* CoCo - GCSx Code of Connection (CoCo) is a list of security controls with which ALL LAs must be compliant before their GCSx circuit can be activated. This applies to LAs who are taking a direct connection, or who are connecting via an aggregated gateway.
** OGCBs - Office of Government Commerce buying solutions - OGCBs is the owner of the CSI Framework Agreement, under which the GCSx service has been procured.
*** Stage 1 continues until circuit has been installed - monitored by GC.
